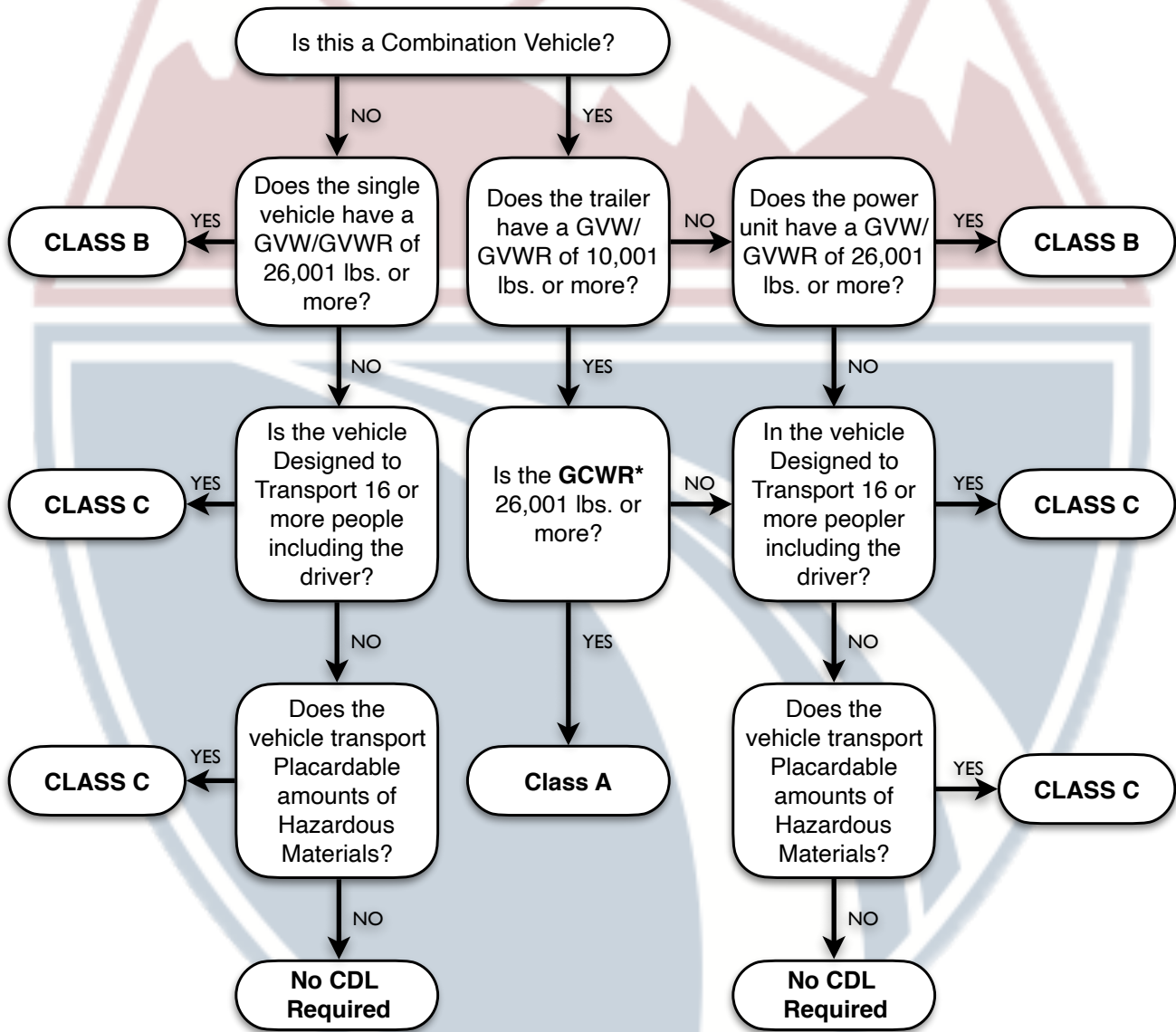


# United States Commercial Drivers License Flowchart Determining CDL Class



**\*Gross Combination Weight Rating (GCWR) is the greater of:**

1. A value specified by the manufacture of the power unit, if such value is displayed on the VIN Label, or
2. The sum of the Gross Vehicle Weight Ratings (GVWRs) or Gross Vehicle Weights (GVWs) of the power unit and the towed unit(s), or any combination thereof, that produces the highest value.

**Exception:** GCWR VIN Plate marking will not be used to define a CMV when the power is not towing another vehicle.

**CDL Endorsements**

- T - Doubles/Triple Trailers
- P - Passenger Vehicle Designed to Transport 16 or more people including the driver
- S - School Bus
- N - Tank Vehicle
- H - Hazardous Material
- X - Combination H/M and Tank
